- Planning and conducting security test and evaluation
- Develops or analyzes Information Systems Security requirements

Job Requirements

- At least a Bachelor's degree and six years general information systems engineering experience with at least three years of systems administration/implementation
- Minimum Interim Top Secret, based on SSBI. TS preferred.
- Military or federal government experience is preferred
- Experience as a watch stander or manager of a 24x7 Operations Center preferred
- Project experience in sys engineering disciplines like backup and recovery, fail-over and clustering, system and network security, performance engineering and capacity planning
- CISSP strongly desired, professional certifications such as CISA, SANS GIAC, MCSE, CCNA are a plus
- Experience with one or more of the following required (two preferred): ISS Internet Scanner, Retina, and Harris STAT
- Experience as system administrator in UNIX, Windows, or Networking
